Skills Instructors will support our development programs by facilitating sessions for our Junior Gryphon Soccer School (Under 6-14) and House League Plus program (Under 7-15). Skills Instructors are leaders on the field and are responsible for set up, following a session plan, and providing a positive playing experience to all players.

Job Duties & Responsibilities

- Follow and implement a session plan in accordance with Long Term Player Development and Club based curriculum.
- Lead/coach a group of players through a session plan while promoting a positive, inclusive, and fun environment.
- Help with field setup each session by marking out the field with cones, setting up nets, and ensuring all equipment is stored safely after the session has concluded.
- Deliver exceptional customer service when interacting with parents, players, and other staff.
- Prioritize child well-being and safety of participants.
- Promote participation and encourage teamwork from players throughout the session.
- Support and promote the HIGH FIVE "Principles of Healthy Child Development" (PHCD).
- Attend coach development sessions as scheduled by Guelph Soccer Technical Director.
